Contrary to local rumors, the tower of the building was NOT used for executions. The tower served as the home for the sheriff and his family when it was the location of the jail.

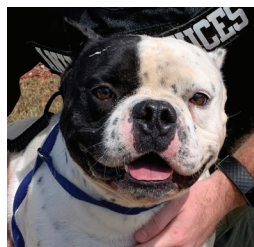
