Dozens of Volunteers Collect Nearly Two Hundred Bags of Trash in Monthly Litter Cleanup

LaGrange, Ga. November 5, 2022 – More than fifty volunteers joined the City of LaGrange for its monthly litter cleanup today Saturday, November 5th. The group helped to collect nearly 200 bags of trash and 15 tires.
