City of LaGrange Names Bulloch Assistant City Manager

LaGrange, Ga. February 10, 2020 – The City of LaGrange is proud to announce **Bill Bulloch** has been named Assistant City Manager.

Bulloch most recently served as the Business Development Executive with the Georgia Vocational Rehabilitation Agency where he worked with Georgia's corporate employers to initiate workforce development strategies and programs to build an inclusive workforce. He is responsible

for representing the agency in economic development initiatives within the State of Georgia.

Bulloch also served as the 9th Chief Executive Officer/Executive Director of the Roosevelt Warm Springs Institute for Rehabilitation (RWS), the 940-acre rehabilitation center in Warm Springs, Georgia founded by Franklin Delano Roosevelt in 1927. Bulloch oversaw the operations, services and programs of its two medical hospitals and the vocational rehabilitation campus as well as the Cave Spring, Georgia vocational rehabilitation campus.

Bulloch has an extensive and diverse executive management background. Before taking on the role as Chief Executive Officer, Bulloch served as the Deputy Executive Director and the Director of Human Resources Management and Development for Roosevelt Warm Springs. His previous public sector experience includes Assistant Human Resources Director for the Georgia Regional Hospital at Savannah, and the Regional Assistant Human Resources Director for the Middle Georgia Facility System. His private sector experience includes management level positions within the manufacturing industry as well as industrial manufacturing sales.

“I am both excited and honored to serve as the City of LaGrange Assistant City Manager,” said Bulloch. “Since moving to LaGrange almost ten years ago, I recognized how fortunate we are to live in a community that is innovative in its approach to economic development, tourism and community improvement. I look forward to working alongside City Manager Kelsey, Mayor Thornton, the LaGrange City Council and the rest of the City of LaGrange team.”

Bulloch is a member of the Georgia Economic Developers Association, served on the Meriwether County Chamber of Commerce and Tourism Board, previous ex-officio board member of the Roosevelt Warm Spring Development Fund, and former treasurer of the National Consortium of State Operated Comprehensive Rehabilitation Centers.

A graduate of Georgia Southern University, Bulloch resides in LaGrange with his wife Stacie and their two children Cole and Reese.
